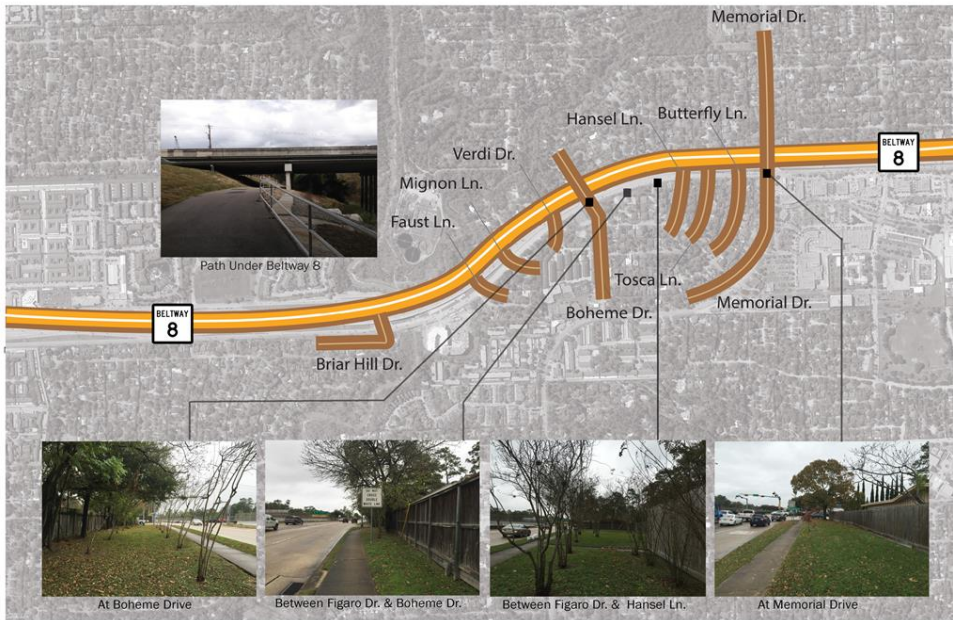

Meeting Purpose

- Inform community leaders about the Beltway 8 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Project and gather input on the planning and proposed design improvements
- Build a community-driven effort in partnership with the City of Houston; TIRZ 17; Memorial Management District; and other stakeholders

Benefits

- Enhance safety for pedestrians and cyclists
- Provide ramps and sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance
- Improve mobility and connectivity
- Create public space for passing and resting areas
- Increase recreational use of Terry Hershey Park

Proposed Improvements

- Connect neighborhoods between Memorial Drive and Briar Hill Drive, to Terry Hershey Park and other nearby activity centers with a proposed path along Beltway 8 in Harris County
- Expand existing 4-foot wide sidewalk to 8-foot wide concrete path (6 feet at some locations)
- Add ADA compliant curb ramps and sidewalks
- Estimated total project cost: \$582,000
- Estimated letting (bid contract): Late Winter/Early Spring 2018
- Estimated construction: Late Spring/Early Summer 2018 (duration is 3-4 months)
